## Head Coach: Trent Cull

Trent Cull begins his first year with the Canucks organization after becoming the second Head Coach in Utica Comets history on June 28, 2017. He replaces Travis Green, who went on to become the Head Coach of the Vancouver Canucks after serving four years with the organization. Cull, 43, joins the Canucks' AHL affiliate after having significant coaching and playing experience in the league. He has served as Assistant Coach of the Syracuse Crunch for the past 4 seasons, his second stint with the team after serving in the same role from 2006-10. Last season, Cull helped Syracuse win the Eastern Conference Championship and clinch a berth in the 2017 Calder Cup Final. Cull was also Head Coach of the OHL's Sudbury Wolves for three seasons (2010 to 2013) compiling a 94-88-11-11 record, and Assistant Coach of the OHL's Guelph Storm for two seasons prior to joining the Syracuse Crunch. Prior to his coaching career, the Georgetown, Ontario native played 11 seasons as a defenseman in the AHL and IHL with five teams: St. John's, Houston, Springfield, Wilkes-Barre/Scranton and Syracuse. He totaled 618 games as a pro, tallying 28 goals and 79 assists for 107 points as well as 1,629 penalty minutes. He won the IHL's Championship Trophy, the Turner Cup, as a member of the 1998-99 Houston Aeros. Cull also played 5 seasons in the OHL for Owen Sound, Windsor and Kingston.

## Associate Coach: Gary Agnew

Agnew, 57, enters his first season with the Utica Comets and adds over 30 years of experience coaching at the NHL, AHL and junior levels. He most recently worked as an Assistant Coach with the Pittsburgh Penguins from 2014 to 2016 and prior to that Assistant Coach with St. Louis from 2012 to 2014. A native of Niagara Falls, Ontario, Agnew was a Columbus Blue Jackets assistant coach for four seasons from 2006-10, helping the Blue Jackets make the organization's first-ever playoff appearance in 2008-09. He also served a brief stint as interim head coach for Columbus. Prior to joining the Blue Jackets, Agnew was head coach of Columbus' AHL affiliate in Syracuse for six years. During his tenure in Syracuse, Agnew established a franchise record by winning 200 games, as well as the team's first division title in 2001-02. Agnew has 11-plus years of head coaching experience in the OHL, including stops Oshawa (2011-12), London (1997-2000; 1990-94) and (1994-97). During his OHL coaching career, Agnew earned OHL Coach of the Year honors in 1992-93 and 1997-98 with London and led Kingston to its only division title in franchise history in 1994-95. Agnew played four seasons of college hockey at the University of New Brunswick before playing professionally in the International and American Hockey Leagues for two years. Following his playing days, Agnew began his coaching career as an assistant coach at the University of New Brunswick.

## **Assistant Coach: Jason King**

Jason King enters his second year with the Comets as an Assistant Coach. Prior to accepting this position, he spent three seasons with the St. John's Ice Caps. His post-playing career included two seasons as an assistant coach and one as the Director of Hockey Operations. King was drafted in the 7th round (212th overall) in the 2001 NHL Entry Draft by the Vancouver Canucks. The Corner Brook, Newfoundland native made his NHL debut in the 2002-03 season. A year later, King made a splash with the Canucks when he was featured on a line with perennial all-stars Henrik and Daniel Sedin, and earned Rookie of the Month honors for November while scoring 12 goals in 47 games that season. King finished his 11-year pro career a veteran of 59 NHL games, 335 AHL games and 140 DEL games (Germany). The forward spent two seasons with St. John's from 2011-2013, leading the club in goal scoring in 2011-12 and earning Community Man of the Year honors for his efforts in the community. In 2013-14, his first season behind the bench, King helped coach the IceCaps to their first-ever Calder Cup Finals after a fourth place finish in the AHL's Eastern Conference and a franchise record 99 points.

## **Player Development Goaltending Consultant: Curtis Sanford**

Sanford, 37, enters his first season as Player Development Goaltending Consultant. In his role, Sanford will assist with the development of goaltending prospects both at the AHL and junior levels. Sanford completed his 15-year professional career after the 2014-15 season in the KHL with the Yaroslavl Lokomotiv. The Owen Sound, Ontario native competed in 144 career NHL games, 35 of which were with the Canucks from 2007-2009. In addition, Sanford appeared in 251 career AHL games as well as an appearance in the 2011 AHL All-Star Classic. He was also named to the 2010-11 AHL second All-Star Team and possessed the best goals against average in the AHL with a 1.93 GAA. He began his coaching career as coach with the Owen Sound Jr. Attack in 2015-16 and coach with the Grey Bruce Highlanders AAA in 2016-17.
