#### Stacy Roest — General Manager, Syracuse Crunch | Assistant General Manager, Tampa Bay Lightning

NHL veteran Stacy Roest enters his 11th season with the Tampa Bay Lightning in 2022-23 and his fourth as assistant general manager – director of player development, a post he was promoted to on May 6, 2019. Roest also assumed the role of general manager of the American Hockey League's Syracuse Crunch, the Lightning's top minor league affiliate. Previously, Roest was brought into the organization as director of player development on July 1, 2013.

Roest, 48, has worked extensively with the Syracuse Crunch since joining the organization and has been a vital member of Tampa Bay's player development process, both on and off the ice. He also has planned and ran the Lightning's offseason prospect and development camps while providing support and tracking the athletes' progress with their collegiate, junior and/or minor league teams. He spent seven seasons in the previous position before promotion to assistant general manager of the Lightning and general manager of the Crunch. He will remain focused on player development while also managing the minor league roster and Tampa Bay's professional relationship with the Crunch and its management team.

The Lethbridge, Alberta native played in 244 career NHL games with the Detroit Red Wings and Minnesota Wild. He finished his NHL career, posting 28 goals and 76 points. Roest also skated in 309 career American Hockey League games, collecting 99 goals and 286 points. He finished his career playing for the Rapperswil-Jona Lakers, in Switzerland's top league, from the 2003-04 season until he retired in 2012. Roest also represented Canada at the Spengler Cup seven times during his career, captaining the team twice.

#### J.P. Cote – Director of Player Development, Tampa Bay Lightning

J.P. Cote is entering his fourth season as the Lightning's director of player development after being hired on August 1, 2019. Cote reports directly to assistant general manager - director of player development Stacy Roest and will work specifically with individual players in the Tampa Bay system on all aspects of the game, both on and off the ice. Cote, 40, will also help plan and run the team's prospect and development camps during the offseason and keep track of Lightning prospects' progress with their collegiate, junior and minor league teams.

The Quebec native skated in 27 career NHL games, including 19 with Tampa Bay during the 2013-14 season, posting four assists and 26 penalty minutes. He played three seasons for the Crunch from 2012 to 2015, totaling 181 games; he helped the Crunch earn their first berth in the Calder Cup Finals in 2013. Cote served as a pro and amateur scout for the San Jose Sharks in 2018-19.

#### Mike Ellis – Director of Skill Development, Tampa Bay Lightning

Mike Ellis is entering his fourth season as the Lightning's director of skill development after being hired in 2019. Ellis, 49, works closely with players in Tampa Bay and Syracuse to develop different on-ice skills.

The Ontario native joins the Lightning organization following five seasons as a skill development consultant for the Toronto Maple Leafs and their AHL affiliate the Toronto Marlies, where he helped the Marlies capture the Calder Cup in 2018. As a player, Ellis primarily played in England; he also coached in England and Italy.



#### Benoit Groulx — Head Coach (7th Season)

Groulx, 54, enters his seventh season as head coach of the Crunch after he was hired on May 10, 2016. In his first season in Syracuse, Groulx coached the Crunch to the franchise's second Calder Cup Finals appearance. Under his leadership, the Crunch won the North Division with a 38-24-7-7 regular season mark before rolling through the Eastern Conference playoffs with an 11-5 record through the first three rounds. The Crunch were defeated by the Grand Rapids Griffins in the 2017 Calder Cup Finals, four games to two.

In his second season with the Crunch, Groulx guided a rookie-laden team to the best regular season in franchise history, posting a 46-22-3-5 record. It was the third time in franchise history the team reached 100 points and their 0.658 points percentage was the best in team history at the time. A first-round sweep gave the Crunch a playoff series win in back-to-back years for the first time in team history. It was also the first time the Crunch won a playoff series in the same year as their NHL affiliate.

Groulx and the Crunch improved again in his third season at the helm, leading the Crunch to a 47-21-4-4 record, matching their franchise record for wins (47) and points (102). It was the second straight 100-point season and the fourth in franchise history. The spercentage established another new franchise record. Through six seasons, Grouly holds a 221-126-28-23 record with the Crunch.

team's 0.671 points percentage established another new franchise record. Through six seasons, Groulx holds a 221-126-28-23 record with the Crunch. He has the most wins in franchise and his 0.619 points percentage is second among head coaches in franchise history behind Jon Cooper (0.662). He is the only coach to lead the Crunch to the playoffs each (completed) season.

He had been the head coach and general manager for the Gatineau Olympiques of the Quebec Major Junior Hockey League during the 2015-16 season, guiding his team to a record of 46-19-2-1. The Olympiques were defeated in the 2016 QMJHL Quarter-Final by the Moncton Wildcats four games to two.

Groulx has worked 13 total seasons as a head coach in the QMJHL with the Hull/Gatineau Olympiques, posting a career record of 460-293-18-59. He led his teams to league championships in 2003, 2004 and 2008, earning QMJHL Coach of the Year honors for the 2003-04 season while coaching the Olympiques.

The Hull, Quebec native also served on the coaching staffs for Team Canada at the 2004 U18 World Championships as well as the 2014 and 2015 IIHF World Junior Championships. Groulx was an assistant coach for the Gold Medal winning Team Canada at the U18 World Championships in 2004. Groulx was also an assistant coach for Team Canada at the World Junior Championships in 2014 as Canada was defeated in the Bronze Medal game by Russia. The following year, Groulx was the head coach for Team Canada, winning the Gold Medal and earning a perfect 7-0 record during the tournament.

Groulx also has two years of head coaching experience in the American Hockey League with the Rochester Americans (2008-09, 2009-10), compiling a record of 73-76-11 while leading the Americans to one Calder Cup playoffs appearance.

Groulx is the ninth head coach in Syracuse Crunch history, replacing Rob Zettler, who had been the team's head coach for three and one-half seasons. Zettler replaced Jon Cooper, the first head coach of the Crunch's Lightning era, March 25, 2013.

#### Éric Veilleux — Assistant Coach (4th Season)

Veilleux, 50, returns for his fourth season as an assistant coach with the Crunch after spending one season as head coach of the Halifax Mooseheads in the QMJHL. In his one season in Halifax, Veilleux led the Mooseheads to a 49-15-2-2 record, good for 102 points, the second-best record in franchise history. He then brought the Mooseheads to the QMJHL President's Cup Final and the 2019 Memorial Cup Final, losing to the Rouyn-Noranda Huskies.

Prior to his time in Halifax, Veilleux served as head coach of the San Antonio Rampage from 2016 to 2018. He was also head coach of the Norfolk Admirals in their inaugural season in the ECHL (2015-16) after joining the Admirals as an assistant in their final AHL season (2014-15).

He spent the previous nine seasons as a head coach in the QMJHL with Baie-Comeau and Shawinigan. In his two seasons with Baie-Comeau, he led the Drakkar to consecutive QMJHL President's Cup Finals in 2012-13 and 2013-14, their first two appearances in the finals. He claimed the 2012 Memorial Cup championship with Shawinigan in his final season with the Cataractes. In his 10 seasons as head coach in the QMJHL, Veilleux holds a 396-223-22-27 record, making the playoffs all 10 years and finishing with a better than 0.500 record nine times. He has led his team to the finals four times and made two appearances in the Memorial Cup. He was named QMJHL and CHL Coach of the Year in 2013-14.

As a player, the Quebec City, Quebec native skated in 447 career AHL games with the Cornwall Aces, Hershey Bears, Kentucky Thoroughblades and Lowell Lock Monsters, totaling 280 points (106g, 174a). He won a Calder Cup with the Bears in 1997.

#### Gilles Bouchard — Assistant Coach (5th Season)

Bouchard, 51, returns for his fifth season as an assistant coach with the Crunch in 2021-22 after spending the previous five seasons with the Rouyn-Noranda Huskies in the QMJHL. He compiled a 204-104-32 record for the Huskies, capturing the QMJHL championship for the first time in franchise history in 2016. He won the QMJHL's Maurice Filion Trophy for General Manager of the Year and the Ron-Lapointe Trophy for Coach of the Year for the 2015-16 season.

Under Bouchard's tutelage, the Crunch featured five 20-goal scorers and two 30-goal scorers, while the team's power play clicked at 20.9%, their best mark since the 2000-01 season.

The Normandin, Quebec native won a silver medal as the Head Coach of Team Canada Red at the 2017 World Under-17 Hockey Challenge.

As a player, Bouchard spent three seasons in the QMJHL from 1988 to 1991 with Shawinigan, Trois-Rivières, Beauport and Chicoutimi. He also played two seasons with the Université de Québec à Trois-Rivières, claiming the Queen's Cup in 1996, followed by a four-year stint in the QSPHL with Louiseville, Asbestos and Thetford Mines from 1996 to 2000.

He replaced Jeff Halpern on the Crunch staff after Halpern was promoted to the same position with the Tampa Bay Lightning.

#### Joe Palmer — Goaltending & Video Coach (4th Season)

Palmer, 34, returns for his fourth season as goaltending & video coach after serving as the director of hockey operations for the Cornell Big Red for three seasons following a season as a volunteer assistant coach with the Big Red in 2015-16. During his time as director of hockey operations, Cornell posted a 67-26-11 record and earned three at-large bids to the NCAA tournament.

As a player, Palmer appeared in 56 career ECHL games with the Florida Everblades, Gwinnett Gladiators, Reading Royals and Toledo Walleye from 2010 to 2012. He also skated in 36 career CHL contests with the Texas Brahmas in 2009-10 and Quad City Mallards in 2012-13.

A native of Utica, New York, Palmer is the founder and primary instructor of Syracuse-based Palmer Goalie Systems, where he has provided personal instruction and video analysis to more than 30 area goaltenders who compete at the AAA, prep school, junior and college levels. He has also served as goaltending consultant with Mountain Hockey Instruction and Syracuse Empire Junior Stars and as a talent evaluator for USA Hockey Festival Central New York tryout camp.
