BRUINS BITES

- The Providence Bruins (33-8-1-0) host the Hartford Wolf Pack (16-22-4-1) for the fifth of 10 matchups this season between the Atlantic Division rivals.
- Providence enters the game on a season-best eight game winning streak.
- The P-Bruins are 3-1 this season against the Wolf Pack.
- On Wednesday, the P-Bruins beat the Bridgeport Islanders 2-1 at Total Mortgage Arena.
- Riley Tufte scored his team leading 19th goal of the season (200th career AHL point).
- Christian Wolanin scored on the power play.
- Goaltender Michael DiPietro stopped 36 of 37 shots faced to post his 15th game of the season allowing one goal or less.
- DiPietro is first in the AHL with a 1.65 goals against average and a .942 save percentage.
- Patrick Brown will serve as playing captain at the AHL All-Star Classic, while DiPietro, Frederic Brunet, and Ryan Mougenel will also represent the Providence Bruins.
- Dans Locmelis will represent Latvia at the upcoming Winter Olympic Games in Milan.


HC - RYAN MOUGENEL



Ryan Mougenel enters his fifth season as head coach of the Providence Bruins after spending the previous three seasons as an assistant coach for the team. Prior to joining the P-Bruins in 2018-19, he spent four seasons as an assistant coach with San Jose's AHL affiliates. He began working under head coach Roy Sommer in 2014 with the Worcester Sharks and kept his role when the franchise relocated to San Jose as the Barracuda. Mougenel's teams made the playoffs each of those seasons highlighted by a Pacific Division Championship and run to the Conference Finals in 2017. His first taste of AHL coaching experience came in 2013-14 as an assistant coach with Hershey.

The native of Scarborough, Ontario got his coaching start in the ECHL with the Fresno Falcons from 2005-2009. Working as the assistant coach, his team made the postseason in each of his first three seasons. He then moved on to become the head coach of the ECHL's Las Vegas Wranglers from 2009-13. The Wranglers qualified for the postseason with Mougenel at the helm in each of his four seasons, highlighted by a run to the Finals in 2011-12. He was a head coach in the 2011 ECHL All Star game and was promoted to General Manager of Las Vegas during his final ECHL season.

Prior to coaching, Mougenel played parts of six pro seasons between the AHL and ECHL. His lone season of AHL action came with Rochester in 1999-00, suiting up in 20 games for the Amerks registering a goal. He spent five years in the ECHL from 1997-03 with Atlantic City, Chesapeake, Hampton Roads and Jackson scoring 105 points (46g-59a) and 271 penalty minutes over 180 games. He was part of Atlantic City's 2003 Kelly Cup Championship team, scoring a goal and eight assists over 17 playoff games.

COACHING STAFF



TRENT WHITFIELD - ASSISTANT COACH



Trent Whitfield enters his ninth season as an assistant coach for the Providence Bruins. The Alameda, Saskatchewan, native recently served as an assistant coach of the Calgary Hitmen of the Western Hockey League (WHL) in 2015-16. The previous season, he was an assistant coach of the Portland Pirates of the American Hockey League (AHL) in 2014-15. Whitfield enjoyed a successful 15-year playing career at the ECHL, AHL, and NHL levels, skating in 194 NHL games with the Boston Bruins, St. Louis Blues, Washington Capitals, and New York Rangers. He compiled 11 goals and 18 assists for 29 points. Whitfield played in 812 games at the AHL level with the Providence Bruins, Peoria Rivermen, and Portland Pirates, totaling 247 goals and 349 assists for 596 points.

RYAN BOURQUE - ASSISTANT COACH



Ryan Bourque enters his first season as an assistant coach for the Providence Bruins. The Boxford, Mass., native spent the 2024-25 season as the Head Coach of Cushing Academy, where he graduated from in 2009. Bourque was an assistant coach at the the U.S. National Team Development Program for the 2023-24 season and an assistant coach for the South Carolina Stingrays of the ECHL from 2021-23. As a player, Bourque appeared in 585 career AHL games for Hartford, Hershey, Bridgeport, and Charlotte, tallying 85 goals and 118 assists for 203 points. The forward notched a career-high 21 goals during the 2013-14 season with Hartford. Bourque, son of former Boston Bruin and Hockey Hall of Fame Inductee Ray Bourque, played two seasons in the QMJHL with the Quebec Ramparts prior to turning professional in 2011.

MIKE DUNHAM - GOALTENDING COACH



Mike Dunham enters his ninth season with the Bruins organization after being named the Goaltender Development Coach in July of 2017. The Johnson City, NY, native joined the Bruins after spending the previous nine seasons with the New York Islanders as their goaltending coach. Dunham was originally selected by New Jersey in the third round (53rd overall) of the 1990 NHL Entry Draft. The netminder played three seasons of college hockey at the University of Maine from 1990-93, earning both Hockey East First Team All-Star and NCAA East First Team All-American honors in 1992-93 as he helped the Black Bears to a national championship. He played his first three professional seasons with Albany in the AHL, then played ten NHL seasons with New Jersey, Nashville, New York Rangers, Atlanta, and New York Islanders. He compiled a 141-178-44 record with a 2.74 GAA and a .908 save percentage in 394 NHL games.


