John Snowden - Head Coach

John Snowden, 44, was named the fifth head coach in Lehigh Valley history on July 14, 2025.

Snowden joined the Phantoms as an assistant coach in the 2022-23 season after spending two years as an assistant coach with the Toronto Marlies. He won a Kelly Cup Championship in the ECHL in 2019 as head coach of the Newfoundland Growlers after stepping in as head coach mid-season. He spent two seasons with Newfoundland following a three-year stint as an assistant with the Orlando Solar Bears.

As a player, Snowden played in 886 career professional games in North America, mostly in the ECHL and the former Central Hockey League. He scored 236 goals with 271 assists for 507 points. He played for the Reading Royals in 2006-07 where he scored 12-18-30 and his career also saw stints with the Texas Wildcatters, Greenville Grrrowl, Amarillo Gorillas, Bloomington PrairieThunder, Quad City Mallards and Fort Worth Brahmas among other teams.

Prior to his professional playing career, he spent time with the U.S. National Development Program Under-18 Team and U.S. National Team in 1998-99 and 1999-2000 and was a USHL Clark Cup Champion with the Lincoln Stars in 2003.

John and his wife, Janelle, have three children: daughter, Rowan, and sons, Aiden and Keegan, who are both players in the Phantoms Youth Hockey program.

Nick Schultz – Assistant Coach

Schultz, 43, is a 15-year NHL veteran as a player who is entering his first season with the Phantoms and first season as an assistant coach.

He spent the last six seasons with the Flyers organization as Assistant Director of Player Development and as a player development coach where he helped guide and mentor developing prospects as they transitioned into the professional game.

Schultz played in 1,069 career NHL games in a 15-season career (2001-17) as a defenseman with Minnesota, Edmonton, Columbus and Philadelphia scoring 30 goals with 145 assists for 175 career points.

The well-respected NHL veteran played the last three seasons of his professional career with the Flyers (2014-17) suiting up for 189 games while scoring 3-26-29 with the Orange and Black. He retired as a player following the 2016-17 season and later returned to the Flyers organization in June 2019 when he was hired as a player development coach.

Terrence Wallin – Assistant Coach

Wallin, 33, enters his first season with the Phantoms arriving from the Maine Mariners of the ECHL where he served as head coach for the past three seasons while overseeing General Manager duties of the team beginning in April 2023.

In his first two seasons as head coach, he led the Mariners to consecutive playoff appearances in 2023 and 2024.

Before moving into coaching, Wally" played for the Mariners in 2018 and 2020 at the end of a five-year professional career that included 300 games in the SPHL, ECHL and AHL. Most of his ECHL career was with the Adirondack Thunder. In the AHL, he played in four games with the Binghamton Devils in 2017-18 and 23 games with the Hartford Wolf Pack in 2018-19.

The Yardley, Pennsylvania native grew up cheering for the Philadelphia Flyers and was a Flyers Cup and Pennsylvania State Champion in 2008 with LaSalle College High School. He played college hockey at Mass-Lowell helping the RiverHawks win back-to-back Hockey East Championships in 2013 and 2014.

Patrick McDonough – Video Coach

McDonough, 32, most recently served 3 years as Video Coordinator and Assistant to Men's Ice Hockey Operations at the University of New Hampshire, focusing on pre-scouts, live tagging, postgame analysis, and the use of advanced video and analytics platforms including Catapult and iBench tools, SportLogiq and InStat. The Kensington, NH native brings coaching and leadership experience from the collegiate and youth levels, including time as Head Coach of UNH Women's ACHA Hockey and as an executive member of the New Hampshire East Eagle

Brady Robinson – Goaltending Coach

Robinson, 43, enters his 11th season with the Philadelphia Flyers as a Goaltending Development Coach and he also serves specifically as Goaltending Coach with the Lehigh Valley Phantoms. Robinson works with the goaltenders with the Lehigh Valley Phantoms while also overseeing and evaluating the goaltending prospects throughout the organization in addition to amateur scouting. He had previously served as a goaltending coach for nine seasons with the WHL Victoria Royals while also serving on Hockey Canada's goaltending advisory board.
