THE STORY COMING IN

The Bridgeport Islanders face their two closest rivals in a trio of games this weekend, beginning tonight against the Hartford Wolf Pack inside the XL Center. The Islanders return to Webster Bank Arena on Saturday for a 7 p.m. matchup against the Springfield Thunderbirds before rounding out the weekend against Hartford on Sunday (3 p.m.). Bridgeport has won three of its last four games, but suffered a 5-1 loss to the Wolf Pack in its most recent outing on Halloween. Austin Czarnik scored his first goal with the Islanders late in the second period, and Cory Schneider made 30 saves in his season debut. Bridgeport is still looking for its first road win of 2021-22.

ISLANDERS VS. WOLF PACK

Tonight's game is the third of 10 meetings between the Islanders and Wolf Pack this season, and the second of six matchups at XL Center. Hartford has won each of the first two meetings, including a 2-1 decision in the season opener on Oct. 15th. Chris Terry scored Bridgeport's lone goal that night. Both Jakub Skarek and Cory Schneider have spent time in the crease versus Hartford, while Keith Kinkaid has played each game for the Wolf Pack (2-0-0 record, 1.01 GAA, .973 save percentage).

VIEW FROM HARTFORD

The Wolf Pack have won three of their last four games and have points in five of their last six (4-1-1-0). The New York Rangers' affiliate is tied for third in the Atlantic Division after Sunday's win at Bridgeport, led by Tanner Fritz, Tim Gettlinger and Anthony Greco who each had one goal and an assist. Hartford's defense is third in the AHL (1.88 goals against/game), allowing three goals or fewer in every game.

SKAREK'S STREAK

Jakub Skarek has won each of his last three starts and is unbeaten in regulation in seven of his last eight games dating back to April (5-1-2). He has a 2.28 goals-against-average and .929 saves rate over his last three starts including a 37-save shutout against Laval on Oct. 24th. He currently ranks eighth among AHL goaltenders in minutes played (307:33) and is tied for third in wins (3).

EL DURANDEAU

Arnaud Durandau co-leads the Islanders with six points (one goal, five assists) in eight games. He has found the scoresheet with a point in all but two games this season and enters the weekend on a two-game scoring streak (two assists). His goal came on the power play on Oct. 23rd to help propel the Isles to a four-goal come-from-behind win against Springfield in the home opener. Durandau, a third-year winger, was drafted by the New York Islanders in the sixth round (#165 overall) in 2017.

Otto Koivula has six points in his last six games (one goal, five assists) and co-leads the club in scoring with Durandau. He rang a shot off the crossbar late in Sunday's loss to Hartford, but saw his five-game point/assist streak come to an end. Koivula's five-game assist streak is the second longest in the AHL this season. It was also tied for the second longest point streak of his AHL career.

Austin Czarnik leads the Isles with 28 shots-on-goal, which is also tied for seventh in the AHL... Czarnik is three contests away from his 200th AHL game... BRIDGEPORT ISLANDERS: TEAM BIOGRAPHIES

BRENT THOMPSON - HEAD COACH

Brent Thompson is in his ninth season as head coach of the Bridgeport Islanders, which also marks his 11th year in the New York Islanders organization. Thompson was originally hired to coach Bridgeport on June 28, 2011 and led the team to a division title in 2011-12 before being named assistant coach of the New York Islanders for two seasons (2012-14). On May 2, 2014, the Islanders announced Thompson would return to his role as head coach in Bridgeport. Thompson became the team's all-time winningest head coach on Jan. 28, 2017, passing Jack Capuano with his 134th career victory.

He is **266-229-56** in **551** career regular-season games as Bridgeport's head coach.

Prior to his time in Bridgeport, Thompson served as head coach of the Alaska Aces (ECHL) for two years (2009-11), winning the Kelly Cup Championship in 2011. During his two seasons as head coach in Alaska, Thompson amassed a record of 83-50-11 and won the John Brophy Award as ECHL Coach of the Year in 2011 after leading the team to a record of 47-22-3. Thompson also served as a player/coach with the CHL's Colorado Eagles in 2003-04 and was an assistant with the AHL's Peoria Rivermen from 2005-09.

Before joining the coaching ranks, Thompson enjoyed a 14-year professional playing career from 1991-2005, which included 121 NHL games and more than 900 professional contests. The Calgary, Alberta native was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Kings in the second round (39th overall) of the 1989 NHL Entry Draft.

RICK KOWALSKY - ASSISTANT COACH

Rick Kowalsky was named assistant coach of the Bridgeport Islanders on August 3, 2021. He joins the organization following three seasons as assistant coach with the New Jersey Devils.

The Simcoe, Ontario native was head coach of New Jersey's AHL affiliate for eight seasons, guiding the Albany Devils (2010-17) and the Binghamton Devils (2017-18). In addition, Kowalsky was head coach of New Jersey's ECHL affiliate for four seasons, leading the Trenton Titans and Trenton Devils from 2006-10. He was elected into the ECHL Hall of Fame in 2017.

Kowalsky led Albany to back-to-back playoff berths in 2015-16 and 2016-17, including its most successful season in 2015-16. The Devils earned 46 wins and 102 points that season, and Kowalsky was named AHL Coach of the Year. He also guided ECHL Trenton to a 40-win season in 2008-09 and received the John Brophy Award as the league's top coach. Trenton's 40 wins were the most since 2004-05 when the Titans won the Kelly Cup Championship with Kowalsky as team captain.

Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Kowalsky enjoyed a 12-year professional playing career as a forward in the AHL and ECHL. He had 92 points (35 goals, 57 assists) in 183 AHL games with the Cornwall Aces, Portland Pirates and Norfolk Admirals, and 550 points (221 goals, 329 assists) in 516 ECHL contests with the Hampton Roads Admirals, Trenton Titans and Roanoke Express. He skated in the 1995 and 2003 ECHL All-Star Games and served as North team captain in 2003.

CHRIS TERRERI - GOALTENDING COACH

Chris Terreri was named goaltending coach with Bridgeport on August 23, 2017 and returns for his fifth season in that capacity. Terreri works with goalies throughout the Islanders organization, including those playing with the Worcester Railers (ECHL) and amateur prospects.

Prior to joining the Islanders, Terreri spent 16 seasons as a member of the New Jersey Devils coaching staff. He served eight years as goaltending coach, working with Martin Brodeur, Cory Schneider and others.

In 15 seasons as a player, Terreri appeared in 406 NHL games with the Devils, San Jose Sharks, Chicago Blackhawks and Islanders (two games). He won two Stanley Cups with New Jersey in 1995 and 2000. Terreri was New Jersey's fifth-round pick (85th overall) in the 1983 Entry Draft. He joined the Devils after a four-year career at Providence College, which included two NCAA Frozen Four appearances.

On the international stage, Terreri was a member of the United States Olympic Team in 1988. He also represented the U.S. during the 1985, '86, '87 and '97 World Championships.
