Head-to-head:

This is the fourth of ten meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Bruins this season. It is the second of five matchups between the foes at PeoplesBank Arena. The Bruins have won each of the first three head-to-head matchups. The Wolf Pack are 0-2-1-0 in their three losses, having picked up a point in a 3-2 overtime loss on Nov. 12. The Bruins claimed a 4-1 victory in the last meeting on Jan. 2. **Matěj Blümel** broke the ice 17:01 into the game, potting his third goal of the season from the slot after a turnover. **Brennan Othmann** buried the equalizer 9:13 into the second period, taking a pass from **Trey Fix-Wolansky** in the right-wing circle. **Dans Locmelis** restored the lead for good at 18:06, however, firing home a rebound from the left-wing side. **Georgii Merkulov** made it 3-1 17:42 into the third period with an empty net strike, then **Locmelis** made it 4-1 at 18:27 with another empty-net tally. The Wolf Pack are 3-9-1-0 in their last 13 head-to-head matchups with the Bruins. Each team was 0-for-2 on the power play on Jan. 2 in Hartford.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack surrendered five unanswered goals last night in a 7-4 loss against the Springfield Thunderbirds at the MassMutual Center. After falling behind 2-0, the Wolf Pack scored four unanswered goals to make it 4-2 by the 3:22 mark of the second period. **Bryce McConnell-Barker**, **Brandon Scanlin**, **Kalle Väisänen**, and **Othmann** scored for Hartford. **Dillon Dube** and **Matthew Peca** struck late in the period for the Thunderbirds, tying the game 4-4. Early in the third period, **Alek Kaskimäki** struck on the power play, putting Springfield ahead for good. **Dylan Peterson** and **Chris Wagner** tacked on insurance markers, with **Wagner's** goal coming into an empty net. **Othmann** recorded two points (1 g, 1 a) in the loss. He has points in five straight games (4 g, 2 a). G **Dylan Garand** recorded his first career assist last night, the secondary helper on **McConnell-Barker's** first period power play goal. The Wolf Pack are 3-6-0-1 in their last ten games. They are 5-9-3-0 at home this season.

Bruins Notebook:

The Bruins won their third straight game last night, 4-1 at home against the Bridgeport Islanders. **Cam Thiesing** had the Isles up 1-0 after one, but the final four goals of the game belonged to the Bruins. **Locmelis** tied the game 15:34 into the second period with his 13th goal of the season. Less than a minute later, at 16:26, **Christian Wolanin** potted the game-winning goal, making it 2-1. **Victor Söderström** made it 3-1 just 5:28 into the third period, then **Blümel** hit the empty net at 19:34 to cement the victory. The Bruins are 13-2-1-0 on the road this season. Only the Grand Rapids Griffins (14) have more road victories. The Bruins are 7-2-1-0 in their last ten away games.
