# Head-to-head:

This is the third of ten meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Bruins this season. It is the first of five matchups between the foes in the Connecticut capital. The Bruins have claimed each of the first two meetings, kicking off the season series with a 2-0-0-0 record. The Wolf Pack are 0-1-1-0 to this point in the season series. The Bruins claimed a 3-2 overtime victory in the last meeting on Nov. 12 in Providence. Tied 1-1 through 40 minutes of play, **Patrick Brown** struck on the power play at 12:43 of the third period to give the home side a 2-1 lead. Late in the frame, the Wolf Pack would go to the power play when **Riley Tufte** was whistled for hooking. The club would opt for the extra attacker, going six-on-four. On the two-man advantage, Dylan Roobroeck struck at 17:40 to tie the game and force overtime. 3:28 into overtime, however, **Fabian Lysell** potted his sixth goal of the season to give the Bruins the second point. The Bruins went 7-3-0-0 against the Wolf Pack in last season's ten-game series. The Wolf Pack are 3-8-1-0 in their last 12 games against the Bruins. The Wolf Pack were 2-3-0-0 against the Bruins on home ice during the 2024-25 campaign.

## **Wolf Pack Notebook:**

The Wolf Pack were shutout at home for the third time this season on New Year's Eve, 4-0 at the hands of the Bridgeport Islanders. Alex Jefferies opened the scoring 11:00 into the second period when he ripped a shot from the right-wing circle. The goal, his seventh of the season, proved to be the game-winning strike. 18 seconds later, at 11:18, Liam Foudy made it 2-0 when he cut to the front of the net and potted his fifth goal of the season on a backhand bid. Adam Beckman and Chris Terry tacked on insurance markers in the third period. Henrik Tikkanen made 32 saves for the shutout. It marked the second time this season the Wolf Pack were shutout at home by the Islanders. The Wolf Pack are just 5-8-3-0 at home this season, and have lost each of their last three at home in regulation time. On Thursday, the parent New York Rangers assigned F Brennan Othmann to Hartford. Also on Thursday, the Rangers recalled F's Brett Berard, Anton Blidh, and Justin Dowling.

## **Bruins Notebook:**

The Bruins dropped a 4-2 decision to the Springfield Thunderbirds at the MassMutual Center on Wednesday afternoon. After taking a 1-0 lead at 4:01 of the hockey game on **Victor Söderström's** second goal of the season, the Bruins surrendered three unanswered goals and were never able to regain the momentum. **Matt Luff** tied the contest at 5:17 with his tenth goal of the season, then **Jakub Stancl** potted his sixth goal of the season on the power play at 12:42 to make it 2-1. **Sam Stange** notched the eventual game-winning goal 10:28 into the second period, his third strike of the season. **Brown** and **Aleksanteri Kaskimäki** traded tallies in the third period. The sides combined for 64 penalty minutes, with the Bruins accounting for 44 of those minutes. The loss dropped the Bruins to 12-2-1-0 on the road this season. They sit second in the AHL in road victories with 12, trailing only the Grand Rapids Griffins (13).
