Head-to-head:

This is the seventh of 12 meetings in the 'Battle of Connecticut' between the Wolf Pack and the Islanders this season. The Islanders have won four of the first six meetings, posting a record of 4-2-0-0. The Wolf Pack are 2-4-0-0 against the Islanders. The Islanders have also claimed both meetings in Hartford. They scored a 3-0 shutout victory on Oct. 24, then blanked the Wolf Pack again on Dec. 31 by a score of 4-0. In the most recent meeting, the Islanders stormed back to defeat the Wolf Pack 5-1 on Jan. 11 in Bridgeport. **Jaroslav Chmelar** had the Wolf Pack up 1-0 after two periods, deflecting a **Brandon Scanlin** shot home at 7:28 of the middle stanza. The goal was his fifth of the season. **Isaiah George** potted his own rebound at 2:33 of the third period, however, tying the game and kicking off a stretch of five unanswered goals for the Islanders. **Hunter Drew's** power play marker at 4:16 gave the Islanders the lead for good, then **Eetu Liukas** buried an insurance tally 31 seconds later to make it 3-1. **Liam Foudy** and **Sean Day** both scored late, ballooning the lead to 5-1. The Wolf Pack's last head-to-head win over the Islanders came in Bridgeport on Jan. 3 by a score of 4-1.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack won their third game in their last four outings on Tuesday night, handing the Hershey Bears a 5-4 defeat in overtime at the Giant Center. **Trey Fix-Wolansky** scored twice in the first period, putting the Pack up 2-0 through 20 minutes. He opened the scoring just 32 seconds in, then tacked on an insurance marker at 3:19. **Bryce McConnell-Barker** made it 3-0 14:22 into the second period, ripping his seventh goal of the season from the left-wing circle. **Brett Leason** made it 3-1 at 15:48, but **Fix-Wolansky** restored the three-goal lead and completed his hat-trick at 17:46. **Fix-Wolansky** was awarded a penalty shot and beat **Clay Stevenson** through the five-hole to make it 4-1. His hat-trick was the first by a Wolf Pack player this season, and the first since **Alex Belzile** against the Islanders on Dec. 4, 2025. Three straight goals from the Bears forced overtime, however. **Leason** made it 4-2 at 18:50 of the second period, then **Ilya Protas** and **Graeme Clarke** struck in a span of 22 seconds early in the third period. In overtime, the Wolf Pack went to the power play 92 seconds in. On the power play, **McConnell-Barker** potted his second goal of the night with a shot from the left-wing circle that beat **Stevenson** by the shoulder. The Wolf Pack are now 9-9-1-1 on the road this season. They are just 6-9-3-0 at home.

Islanders Notebook:

The Islanders picked up a 6-2 victory on Monday afternoon at home against the Lehigh Valley Phantoms. The win was their fifth in a row. The Isles led 4-0 after one period of play, striking three times on the power play in the opening frame. **Joey Larson** opened the scoring 6:39 into the game, then **Adam Beckman** rattled off a natural hat-trick to blow the game open. **Beckman** scored on the power play at 12:39 and 19:56, while also striking five-on-five at 15:26. **Garrett Wilson** got the Phantoms on the board 9:02 into the middle frame, but a **Foudy** shorthanded strike at 11:52 extended the lead to 5-1 for the Islanders. **Jacob Gaucher** and **Drew** traded goals in the third period, with **Drew's** strike coming on the power play for the Isles. The Islanders went four-for-six on the power play in the victory and a perfect three-for-three on the penalty kill.
