Head-to-head:

This is the first of two meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Marlies this season. The sides will meet in Toronto on Saturday, Mar. 21, at 4:00 p.m. The Wolf Pack and Marlies did not meet during the 2024-25 season, meaning this is their first matchup since Mar. 23, 2024. It is the Marlies first visit to Hartford since Dec. 17, 2023. The Marlies swept the season series two seasons ago, going 2-0-0-0. The Wolf Pack went 0-1-1-0 in the head-to-head matchup. The Marlies took a 5-1 decision on home ice on Mar. 23, 2024. They won 4-3 in overtime in Hartford on Dec. 17, 2023. **Topi Niemelä** scored the overtime winner in the Marlies last visit to Hartford. The Wolf Pack's last victory against the Marlies came on Apr. 5, 2023, by a final score of 2-1 on home ice. **Jake Leschyshyn** potted the game-winning goal 1:42 into the extra session that night.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack won their fourth game in their last five tries on Friday night, knocking off the Bridgeport Islanders 3-2 at PeoplesBank Arena. **Liam Foudy** put the Islanders up 1-0 6:47 into the game with a power play goal, but three unanswered goals from the Wolf Pack would give them the lead for good. **Juuso Pärssinen** tied the game 1-1 at 7:53 when a **Trey Fix-Wolansky** pass clipped him and found the back of the net. Then, at 10:55, a **Brendan Brisson** shot from the left-wing circle leaked through **Henrik Tikkainen** to make it 2-1. **Justin Dowling** extended the lead to 3-1 18:23 into the third period, hitting the empty net. **Chris Terry** scored with the extra attacker at 19:34, drawing the Islanders within a goal, but **Dylan Garand** stood tall in the final 25 seconds to preserve the two points. With the win, the Wolf Pack are now 16-18-4-1 on the season. They are tied with the Islanders for the final playoff spot in the Atlantic Division with 37 points.

Marlies Notebook:

The Marlies saw a 3-1 lead evaporate in a 4-3 overtime loss to the Springfield Thunderbirds at the MassMutual Center last night. **Bo Groulx** put the Marlies up 3-1 15:45 into the second period, scoring his 19th goal of the season. **Chris Wagner** drew the Thunderbirds within a goal 7:51 into the third period, however, kicking off the rally. **Matt Luff**'s 13th goal of the season came on the power play at 14:29, making it a 3-3 game and forcing overtime. In the extra session, **Theo Linstein** netted the game-winning goal just 43 seconds in. The loss dropped the Marlies to 21-15-2-2 on the season. They are 11-9-2-0 on the road this season. The Marlies will conclude their three-in-three weekend tomorrow against the Providence Bruins at 1:05 p.m. at Amica Mutual Pavilion.
