Head-to-head:

This is the eighth of 12 meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Islanders this season. It is the fourth of six meetings between the rivals at PeoplesBank Arena. The Wolf Pack are 3-4-0-0 in the head-to-head series, while the Islanders have posted a record of 4-3-0-0. In Hartford, the Islanders have won two of three meetings. They claimed a 3-0 triumph on Oct. 24, then blanked the Wolf Pack 4-0 on Dec. 31. The Wolf Pack did, however, win the last meeting 3-2 on Jan. 23 at PeoplesBank Arena. **Liam Foudy** struck on the power play 6:47 into the game, putting the Islanders ahead 1-0. **Juuso Pärssinen** tied the game at 7:53, however, deflecting home a **Trey Fix-Wolansky** pass. **Brendan Brisson** put the Wolf Pack ahead for good 10:55 into the game, striking from the left-wing circle. **Justin Dowling** extended the lead to 3-1 at 18:23 of the third period, hitting the empty net. That goal would stand as the game-winning goal, because at 19:34 **Chris Terry** would strike while the Islanders attacked six-on-five. **Dylan Garand** slammed the door shut over the final 26 seconds, cementing the two points for the Wolf Pack.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack fell 7-1 at home on Wednesday night at the hands of the Charlotte Checkers. The loss was Hartford's largest margin of defeat this season. **Nate Smith** opened the scoring 5:52 into the game, giving the visitors a lead they never lost. **Ben Steeves** then made it 2-0 at 16:48. **Brett Chorske** extended the lead to 3-0 at 12:03 of the second period, converting on Charlotte's first shot of the frame. Four goals in the third period extended the lead to 7-0. **Jack Studnicka** started the barrage 4:12 into the period, striking shorthanded. It was the ninth shorthanded goal allowed by the Wolf Pack this season, the second most allowed in the AHL. **Chorske** tacked on his second of the night at 7:50, then **Wilmer Skoog** and **Riese Gaber** lit the lamp at 11:58 and 13:12, respectively, to make it 7-0. **Daniel Walcott** notched the lone goal of the night for the Wolf Pack at 18:29. The club has lost each of their last two games. They fell 4-1 to the Toronto Marlies on Saturday night. The Wolf Pack are just 7-11-3-0 at home this season.

Islanders Notebook:

The Islanders dropped a 4-3 shootout decision to the Providence Bruins on home ice on Saturday. **Adam Beckman** made it a 2-1 game 7:46 into the second period, but three straight Bruins goals put the visitors on top. **Patrick Brown** got the visitors on the board at 14:28, then **Dalton Bancroft** evened the tilt at 17:44. **Riley Tufte** struck at 10:28 of the third period, putting the Bruins ahead 3-2, but 26 seconds later **Foudy** would knot the game 3-3 with his second tally of the night. The Bruins outshot the Islanders 4-1 in the overtime period, but **Marcus Hogberg** stopped all four shots to get the game to the shootout. In the shootout, **John Farinacci** scored the lone goal to give the Bruins the extra point. The Islanders are 0-1-0-1 in their last two games overall. On the road this season, the Isles are 8-9-1-2.
