### **Head-to-head:**

This is the second of six meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Penguins this season. It is the first of three meetings at PeoplesBank Arena. The sides next meet back at PeoplesBank Arena on Friday, Nov. 21. The Penguins claimed a 2-1 victory in the first matchup this season between the foes last Saturday night at Mohegan Arena at Casey Plaza. **Trey Fix-Wolansky** opened the scoring 10:43 into the hockey game, taking a feed from **Gabe Perreault** below the right-wing circle and beating **Sergei Murashov** on a delayed penalty. The Pens pulled even at 8:32 of the second period, however, as **Valtteri Puustinen** took a feed from **Joona Koppanen** in the right-wing circle and beat **Dylan Garand** to make it 1-1. **Owen Pickering** then beat **Garand** through traffic from the point 3:33 into the third period, putting the Pens ahead 2-1. **Murashov** slammed the door shut with five third-period saves to preserve the victory for the Penguins.

#### **Wolf Pack Notebook:**

The loss was the Wolf Pack's seventh straight to the Penguins. They have collected just one of a possible 14 points during this stretch, posting a record of 0-6-1-0. The Wolf Pack has won each of its last two home openers. They blanked the Penguins 5-0 on Oct. 20, 2023, then defeated the Springfield Thunderbirds in a 6-5 thriller on Oct. 18, 2024. The Wolf Pack posted a record of 19-15-1-1 at home during the 2024-25 season. The Wolf Pack's last victory against the Penguins came on Apr. 19, 2024. That night, **Nic Petan** broke a 2-2 tie at 13:22 of the third period as the Wolf Pack claimed a 3-2 victory. On Thursday, the Wolf Pack inked D **Vincent Sévigny** to a professional tryout agreement (PTO). He will wear #8 with the club.

## **Penguins Notebook:**

The Penguins are 2-0-0-0 on the season after defeating the Wolf Pack and the Lehigh Valley Phantoms last weekend. They claimed a 4-1 victory over the Phantoms at the PPL Center on Sunday afternoon. **Aidan McDonough** opened the scoring 4:03 into the game, giving the Pens a lead they never lost. **Avery Hayes** struck 4:08 into the second period on the power play to make it 2-0. His tally would prove to be the eventual game-winning goal. **Helge Grans** struck on the power play at 15:52 of the second period for the Phantoms, but **Tristan Broz** potted two goals in the third period to help the Pens pull away. His first goal came at 5:11 of the final frame, then at 17:59, he hit an empty net. **Filip Larsson** made 26 saves to collect the victory. **Broz** leads the Penguins with two goals and three points (2 g, 1 a).

In overtime, however, it would be the Maple Leafs who escaped with the extra point. **Auston Matthews** struck just 58 seconds in, handing the Rangers their third straight defeat. Now 2-3-1, the Rangers conclude this brief two-game road trip tomorrow at 7:00 p.m. against the Montreal Canadiens.
