Head-to-head:

This is the second of six meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Phantoms this season. Each of the first three meetings will take place at PeoplesBank Arena. The sides will meet again on Saturday, Nov. 22. The final three meetings will take place at the PPL Center in Allentown, PA. The first of those meetings will take place on Saturday, Dec. 20. A season ago, the sides split six games, with each team getting points in five of the six meetings. The Wolf Pack posted a record of 3-1-1-1, while the Phantoms went 3-1-2-0. Each team's lone regulation win in the series came on the road. The Phantoms won 3-0 in Hartford on Jan. 11, 2025, while the Wolf Pack claimed a 4-2 decision on Feb. 8, 2025, in Allentown. Last night, the Phantoms drew first blood with a 4-3 overtime victory. The Wolf Pack jumped out to a 2-0 lead on goals by **Bryce McConnell-Barker** and **Jaroslav Chmelař** by the 33 second mark of the second period. **Tucker Robertson** drew the Phantoms within one at 7:31 of the middle frame, but **Gabe Perreault** quickly restored the two-goal lead at 12:38 with his fourth goal of the season. **Alex Bump** made it 3-2 at 16:27, striking from the left-wing circle, then **Carl Grundström** tied the game on the power play 5:36 into the final frame. In overtime, **Bump** fed **Lane Pederson** one a two-on-one, and the veteran center called game just 36 seconds in.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

Despite last night's loss, the Wolf Pack extended their point streak to a season-high three game (2-0-1-0). The club ended the month of October with a record of 3-4-1-0. **Perreault** has the club's longest goal scoring streak of the season, having struck in each of the last three games. He's recorded six points (3 g, 3 a) during those three games. **Justin Dowling** is also working on a three-game point streak (2 g, 2 a) after recording an assist last night. D **Jackson Dorrington** also recorded an assist on Friday night. He currently leads Wolf Pack defensemen in points with four (4 a) and is tied for the team lead in assists.

Phantoms Notebook:

The Phantoms victory last night was their third straight at PeoplesBank Arena. The win also snapped a three-game road losing streak for the club. D **Carter Berger** recorded the first two points of his AHL career on Friday night, registering two assists. **Pederson's** overtime game-winning goal was his second strike of the season and his first since opening night on Oct. 11. D **Christian Kyrou**, acquired via trade by the parent Philadelphia Flyers from the Dallas Stars on Oct. 30, made his Phantoms debut on Friday night and recorded an assist.
