Head-to-head:

This is the first of two meetings this season between the Wolf Pack and the Americans. It is the only matchup between the foes in the Connecticut capital. The sides will meet in Rochester on Mar. 22, with the puck drop set for 3:05 p.m. The Americans swept the two-game series in 2024-25. Both games finished with identical scores of 6-3. The Americans won the first matchup in Rochester on Nov. 8, then doubled up the Wolf Pack in Hartford on Jan. 25. Over their last ten head-to-head matchups, the Americans have won eight, posting a record of 8-1-1-0. The Wolf Pack are 2-7-1-0 in that span. Hartford's last victory over Rochester came on Jan. 21, 2023, in Hartford by a final score of 4-1. **Cristiano DiGiacinto** recorded the gamewinning goal that night, while **Dylan Garand** made 23 saves to pick up the victory.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack dropped their fifth straight game (0-2-3-0) on Wednesday night, falling 3-2 in overtime against the Providence Bruins in Rhode Island. Joey Abate opened the scoring 14:05 into the second period, tipping home a Jake Schmaltz pass for his first goal of the season. Justin Dowling countered at 18:38, scoring his third goal of the season on a breakaway to make it 1-1 entering the final period. Patrick Brown deflected a Riley Tufte shot by Garand at 12:43 of the third period on the power play, giving the Bruins a late lead. The Wolf Pack again had an answer, this time responding on a six-on-four power play at 17:40. Dylan Roobroeck tipped a shot from Trey Fix-Wolansky by Michael DiPietro to tie the game and force overtime. In overtime, the Bruins outshot the Wolf Pack 6-2 and earned the second point. Fabian Lysell banked a shot off a defenseman and in at 3:28 to give the Bruins their second win against the Wolf Pack in as many tries this season. Roobroeck has now scored in back-to-back games. Garand's 42 saves were the most by a Wolf Pack goaltender in a game this season. The Wolf Pack have points in each of their last three home games (1-0-2-0).

Americans Notebook:

The Americans dropped their second straight on Wednesday night, losing 6-4 at home to the Belleville Senators. The Senators jumped out to a 4-0 lead at the 59 second mark of the third period when **Wyatt Bongiovanni** potted his sixth goal of the season. The Amerks stormed back from there, cutting the lead to 4-3 by the 8:34 mark. **Carson Meyer** got the Amerks on the board with his first goal of the season at 6:14, then **Anton Wahlberg** struck less than a minute later to make it 4-2. At 8:34, **Riley Fiddler-Schultz** made it 4-3 with his second strike of the campaign. **Arthur Kaliyev** got the Senators back up 5-3 at 9:39, but **Jake Leschyshyn** kept Rochester in it with his seventh goal of the year at 16:32. That would be as close as the Amerks drew, however, as **Jan Jenik** hit the empty net at 19:45 to cement the two points. **Leschyshyn**, who played parts of the last three seasons with the Wolf Pack, has scored four goals in his last five games entering action tonight.
