Head-to-head:

This is the third of ten meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Thunderbirds this season in the **I-91 Rivalry**, **presented by Braman Pest**. It is the second of five meetings between the foes in Hartford. The Wolf Pack has won each of the first two head-to-head matchups by a combined score of 9-3. The Pack claimed a 3-0 shutout victory on Oct. 22 at PeoplesBank Arena, then doubled up the Thunderbirds 6-3 at the MassMutual Center on Oct. 25. **Bryce McConnell-Barker** scored the game-winning goal on Oct. 22, while **Carey Terrance** had the deciding marker on Oct. 25. On Oct. 25, the Thunderbirds opened the scoring with a **Corey Schueneman** goal 13:36 into the game. The Wolf Pack scored the next five goals, however, taking a 5-1 lead by the 2:26 mark of the second period. **McConnell-Barker** has recorded three points (2 g, 1 a) in two games against the Thunderbirds this season, while **Dylan Garand** is 2-0-0 in the head-to-head matchup with one shutout.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack suffered their seventh straight defeat (0-3-4-0) on Saturday night, 5-2 to the Laval Rocket. The loss dropped the club to 0-1-1-0 on their current six-game homestand. Trailing 2-0 after 20 minutes of play, the Wolf Pack tied the game on a pair of power play goals. **Dylan Roobroeck** got the club on the board 4:41 into the second period, then **Trey Fix-Wolansky** made it 2-2 4:31 into the third period. It would not be enough, however. **Lucas Condotta** scored at 8:38 on the power play, giving the Rocket a 3-2 lead. **Alex Belzile** then tipped a **Laurent Dauphin** shot by **Garand** at 16:53 on the power play, making it 4-2. **Condotta** scored his second of the game into the empty net at 18:19 to cement the victory. The Wolf Pack scored two power play goals in a single game for the second time this season, but surrendered a season-high three goals against while shorthanded. On Sunday, the Wolf Pack recalled D **Chris Ortiz** from loan to ECHL Bloomington. Also on Sunday, the parent New York Rangers recalled D **Scott Morrow** from the Wolf Pack, assigned F **Gabe Perreault** to the Wolf Pack, and reassigned G **Callum Tung** to the Wolf Pack from Bloomington.

Thunderbirds Notebook:

The Thunderbirds dropped their second straight game on Saturday night, 3-1 to the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins in Pennsylvania. The Pens jumped out to a 2-0 lead on goals from **Raivis Ansons** and **Boko Imama** by the 12:51 mark of period one. **Rutger McGroarty** then ballooned the lead to 3-0 just 66 seconds into the middle frame, giving the Penguins enough offense for two points. **Hugh McGing** got the Thunderbirds on the board 11:52 into the second period, scoring his second goal in the last three games, but that would be all the offense the team generated. The Thunderbirds are 1-6-0-1 on the road this season.
