Head-to-head:

This is the fourth of ten meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Thunderbirds in the 'I-91 Rivalry, presented by Braman Pest'. It is the third of five meetings between the foes at PeoplesBank Arena. The rivalry resumes next back in Hartford on Dec. 5. The Wolf Pack has won each of the first three meetings, posting a record of 3-0-0-0. Most recently, the Pack scored a 3-2 comeback win in overtime on home ice on Nov. 18. Nikita Alexandrov struck 13:08 into the game for the T-Birds, then Logan Mailloux blasted home a power play strike at 16:16. The visitors took their 2-0 lead all the way to the third period, but couldn't hold off the Wolf Pack. Justin Dowling scored four-on-four at 3:11 of the third period, then Brett Berard tied the game with his first goal of the season at 6:59. In the extra session, Casey Fitzgerald notched his first career overtime goal to complete the comeback at 4:27. Callum Tung made 21 saves to collect the victory for the Wolf Pack. Dowling and Fitzgerald each ended the game with two points (1 g, 1 a). The Wolf Pack also beat the Thunderbirds 3-0 on Oct. 22 in Hartford and 6-3 on Oct. 25 in Springfield.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack dropped a 3-2 decision to the Lehigh Valley Phantoms on Saturday night on home ice. Brendan Brisson and Gabe Perreault scored at 10:31 and 15:10, respectively, of the second period to give the Wolf Pack a 2-0 lead through 40 minutes. Three goals from the Phantoms in a span of 4:42 would completely change the game, however. Christian Kyrou made it 2-1 with a power play goal at 2:22, then Carl Grundström tied the game at 5:38 with his fifth goal of the season. Less than two minutes later, **Denver Barkey** potted the game-winning goal off a feed from **Alex Bump**. The loss dropped the Wolf Pack to 2-2-1-0 on their current six-game homestand. The club managed a season-low 19 shots on net in the defeat. The Wolf Pack are now 1-4-2-0 this season when scoring first, and just 4-2-2-0 when leading after two periods of play.

Thunderbirds Notebook:

The Thunderbirds blanked the Utica Comets on Friday night, 2-0, at the MassMutual Center. Leo Lööf opened the scoring 4:04 into the first period, giving the T-Birds a lead they never lost. The goal was Lööf's second of the season and of his career. It marked his first career game-winning goal. Calle Rosén hit the empty net at 18:49 of the third period to cement the victory. Georgi Romanov collected his first career AHL shutout, making 33 saves. The Thunderbirds are 0-2-1-0 against the Wolf Pack this season after going 7-2-0-1 in the season series during the 2024-25 campaign.
