Head-to-head:

This is the fourth of six meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Penguins this season. It is the third and final meeting between the sides in Hartford. The season series concludes with back-to-back meetings in Wilkes-Barre, PA in January. The Penguins hold a 2-1-0-0 record in the season series, while the Wolf Pack are 1-2-0-0. The Pens took each of the first two meetings, knocking off the Wolf Pack 2-1 in Wilkes-Barre on Oct. 11 and 5-2 in Hartford on Oct. 17. The Wolf Pack erupted for five goals in the most recent matchup, beating the Penguins 5-2 at PeoplesBank Arena on Nov. 21. **Anton Blidh** tipped a **Cooper Moore** shot by **Filip Larsson** at 13:21 of the second period, giving the Wolf Pack a 3-2 lead they never lost. **Brett Berard** and **Adam Sýkora** tacked on insurance markers in the third period. The win snapped an eight-game losing streak (1-7-0-0) for the Wolf Pack against the Penguins.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack suffered a 6-2 loss on Saturday night against the Bridgeport Islanders at Total Mortgage Arena. **Adam Beckman** scored just 2:58 into the hockey game, giving the Isles a lead they never lost. **Cam Thiesing** and **Liam Foudy** also struck in the frame, giving the home side a 3-0 lead. **Justin Dowling** and **Brennan Othmann** lit the lamp in the second period for the Wolf Pack, but **Matthew Maggio** and **Marshall Warren** also found the back of the net to keep the lead at three goals. **Foudy** hit the empty net at 16:37 of the third period, cementing the 6-2 result. The loss snapped the Wolf Pack's three-game winning streak overall and three-game point streak (2-0-1-0) on the road. **Dowling's** goal 24 seconds into the second period was the fastest goal scored by the Wolf Pack to start a period this season. On Monday, **G Callum Tung** was reassigned by the parent New York Rangers to the ECHL's Bloomington Bison.

Penguins Notebook:

The Penguins trailed 1-0 after one period on Saturday night in Hershey against the Bears after **Brett Leason** broke the ice at 11:32. The Pens scored the next four goals, however, pulling away for a 4-1 victory. **Valteri Puustinen** tied the game 17:26 into the second period, scoring his third goal of the season. **Puustinen** then broke the tie just 58 seconds into the third period, giving the visitors the lead for good. **Gabe Klassen** and **Aidan McDonough** added insurance markers as the Penguins collected their second straight victory. The Penguins are 9-4-0-0 on the road this season. Overall, they lead the Atlantic Division with a 17-5-1-0 record.
