Head-to-head:

This is the fifth of ten meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Thunderbirds in the 'I-91 Rivalry, presented by Braman Pest'. It is the fourth of five meetings between the foes at PeoplesBank Arena. The rivalry resumes next on Jan. 9 in Springfield. The Wolf Pack are 3-1-0-0 against the Thunderbirds this season. The T-Birds picked up their first victory in the season series in the last meeting on Nov. 26 by a final score of 6-3. Otto Stenberg jammed home a rebound 1:29 into the game, giving the visitors a lead they never lost. Matthew Peca made it 2-0 at 15:35, scoring on the power play. Aleksanteri Kaskimaki made it 3-0 just 1:36 into the middle frame, but the Wolf Pack took over from there. Brennan Othmann and Dylan Roobroeck both struck in the second period to cut the deficit to 3-2. Despite Hartford's push, Matt Luff made it 4-2 6:01 into the third period, scoring the game-winning goal on a breakaway. Samuel Johannesson and Calle Rosen both added insurance markers, while Brendan Brisson scored four-on-four for Hartford. The Wolf Pack defeated the Thunderbirds 3-0 on Oct. 22 and 3-2 in overtime on Nov. 18 at PeoplesBank Arena. Hartford also won the lone meeting at the MassMutual Center, 6-3 on Oct. 25.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack completed a weekend sweep of the Cleveland Monsters with a 3-2 triumph in Ohio on Saturday night. Corson Ceulemans and Hunter McKown scored in the second period for the Monsters, giving them a 2-0 edge through 40 minutes of play. The Wolf Pack struck twice in nine seconds midway through the final stanza, however, turning the game upside down. While playing four-on-four, Gabe Perreault took a pass from Justin Dowling and beat Zach Sawchenko at 11:56 to make it a 2-1 game. Nine seconds later, at 12:05, Trey Fix-Wolansky collected a loose puck and lifted it over the right leg of Sawchenko to tie the game. At 18:59, Brisson fed Perreault in the right-wing circle while on the power play. The rookie's quick shot beat Sawchenko to give the Wolf Pack the lead for good. The goal was Perreault's first career game-winning goal in the AHL, and marked his first multi-goal game as a pro. The win was the Wolf Pack's second this season when trailing by two or more goals. The club is 4-2-0-0 in its last six games.

Thunderbirds Notebook:

The Thunderbirds dropped a 3-2 shootout decision to the Bridgeport Islanders on home ice on Saturday night. Trailing 1-0 after one, **Hugh McGing** tied the game 9:49 into the second period with a power play strike. **Juraj Pekarcik** gave the T-Birds their first lead 9:55 into the third period, potting his fifth goal of the season. Late in the game, with the extra attacker, **Luke Rowe** lit the lamp for the first time as a member of the Islanders, forcing overtime. In the extra session, the Thunderbirds outshot the Islanders 5-0 but could not find the deciding tally. In the shootout, both **Chris Terry** and **Matthew Maggio** scored for the Isles, while both **Peca** and **Nikita Alexandrov** were denied, giving the Islanders the two points. Earlier this week, **Alexandrov** was traded by the parent St. Louis Blues to the Los Angeles Kings in exchange for F **Akil Thomas**.
