Head-to-head:

This is the second and final meeting of the season between the Wolf Pack and Comets. The Wolf Pack claimed the first meeting, 2-1, in Utica on Dec. 12th. **Brennan Othmann** opened the scoring 6:22 into the contest, potting the Wolf Pack's first shorthanded goal of the season. **Lenni Hämeenaho** struck on the power play at 7:10 of the second period, drawing the Comets even. Less than a minute later, however, **Adam Sýkora** restored the lead with the club's second shorthanded goal of the game. The goal, scored at 8:01, would prove to be the game-winning goal. **Dylan Garand** made five saves in the third period, cementing the two points. The Comets won the last meeting in Hartford, 3-2 in the shootout, on Mar. 1, 2025.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack dropped a 9-0 decision to the Charlotte Checkers on Monday afternoon. It marked the fourth time this season that the Wolf Pack were shutout. The nine goals allowed in the game were the most in a single game by the club this season. The nine-goal margin of defeat was the largest in the club's history. **Marek Alischer** potted the game-winning goal 15:04 into the hockey game. The Wolf Pack did earn the weekend split in Charlotte, however, winning 3-2 on Saturday afternoon. **Jaroslav Chmelař** scored the game-winning goal in that victory. This opens the second three-in-three set of the season for the Wolf Pack. They will host the Belleville Senators tomorrow night (7:30 p.m.), then visit the Providence Bruins on Sunday at 3:05 p.m.

Comets Notebook:

The Comets dropped a 2-1 decision to the Bridgeport Islanders in Bridgeport on Tuesday night. **Matthew Maggio** opened the scoring 2:41 into the second period, lighting the lamp for the ninth time this season. **Marc McLaughlin** tied the game 1:31 into the third period, scoring his second goal of the season in just his second game. **Matthew Highmore's** third goal in two games came at 13:30 of the final stanza, breaking the tie and giving the Islanders the lead for good. The Comets have dropped three of their last four games entering action tonight. They are 1-3-0-0 in that span. The club is just 5-13-3-1 on the road this season.


