Head-to-head:

This is the second and final meeting of the season between the Wolf Pack and Senators. The Sens claimed the first meeting, 2-1, on Nov. 8. **Dylan Roobroeck** opened the scoring 14:05 into the hockey game, giving the Wolf Pack a lead through 20 minutes of play. **Arthur Kaliyev** struck on the power play 8:16 into the middle stanza, however, evening the affair. That 1-1 score would hold until the final minute of regulation time. With the Wolf Pack on the power play due to a **Stephen Halliday** tripping call, the Senators would force a turnover in the neutral zone and rush into the offensive end. There, with chaos in front of the goal, **Philippe Daoust** scored shorthanded at 19:55 to stun the Wolf Pack and give the Senators a 2-1 regulation time victory. The sides split two meetings a season ago, with the home team winning both. The Wolf Pack are 1-1-1-0 in their last three meetings with the Senators. The Wolf Pack picked up two points in the last matchup between the foes at PeoplesBank Arena on Mar. 9, 2025. That night, the Wolf Pack set the AHL record for the fastest two goals in league history when **Nathan Sucec** and **Connor Mackey** both notched empty net goals within two seconds of each other in a 4-1 victory.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack dropped a 2-1 decision to the Utica Comets on home ice on Friday night. The loss was the club's ninth in their last ten games (1-8-0-1). After 50:05 of play without a goal, **Ethan Edwards** got the Comets on the board with a blast from the right-wing side that beat **Dylan Garand** through traffic. 2:25 later, **Marc McLaughlin** made it 2-0 with his third goal in as many games. While playing four-on-four, **McLaughlin** carried the puck in on the left-wing side on a two-on-one and snapped a shot that lit the lamp at 12:30. **Juuso Pärssinen** got the Wolf Pack on the board at 17:26, but it would not be enough. He batted home the rebound off a **Travis Dermott** shot for his second goal as a member of the Wolf Pack. The defeat was the club's fifth straight on home ice (0-4-0-1).

Senators Notebook:

The Senators dropped a 5-2 decision to the Providence Bruins in Rhode Island on Friday night. **Brett Harrison** put the Bruins ahead just 27 seconds into the game, but **Kaliyev** would respond at 9:33 with his 30th goal of the season. 9:43 into the second period, **Olle Lycksell** again drew the Sens even when he potted a shorthanded marker to make the game 2-2. Just over five minutes later, at 14:47, **Matej Blumel** restored the lead for good for the Bruins. His tenth goal of the season made it 3-2 and would stand as the game-winner. **Harrison** tacked on a second goal at 19:30 to make it 4-2, then at 19:54 **Joey Abate** put the game out of reach with his second goal of the campaign. The loss was Belleville's fourth in their last five outings.
