Head-to-head:

This is the tenth and final meeting of the season between the Wolf Pack and the Thunderbirds. The Thunderbirds hold a decisive edge in the head-tohead matchup, having won seven of the first nine meetings. All nine games have been determined in regulation time, giving the Wolf Pack a record of 2-7-0-0 in the season series. The Thunderbirds won their third straight in the head-to-head matchup on Feb. 19, taking a 5-3 decision at the MassMutual Center.
