#### Head-to-head:

This is the sixth of ten meetings between the Wolf Pack and Bruins this season. It is the third of five meetings between the rivals in Hartford. The Bruins have claimed four of the first five meetings, posting a 4-1-0-0 record. The Wolf Pack are 1-3-1-0 in the head-to-head matchup. Hartford's lone victory came in the last meeting in the Connecticut capital, 5-1 on Jan. 10. The Bruins claimed a 3-1 victory in the last meeting in Rhode Island last night. **Georgii Merkulov** scored twice in the victory, breaking the ice 17:51 into the game and then potting the insurance at 9:37 of the third period. **Frederic Brunet's** goal 18:36 into the hockey game made it 2-0 at the time and would prove to be the game-winning goal. **Trey Fix-Wolansky** had Hartford's lone tally, a power play strike at 13:59 of the middle stanza. The Bruins are 1-1-0-0 in Hartford, having claimed a 4-1 victory at PeoplesBank Arena on Jan. 2.

#### Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack's loss last night was their fifth consecutive defeat (0-5-0-0). The club has surrendered the first goal in each of the last six games (1-5-0-0). The Wolf Pack are nine-for-nine on the penalty kill against the Bruins in the last two head-to-head matchups. The club has scored two shorthanded goals, both on Jan. 10, in that span. Forward **Brendan Brisson** (1 g, 2 a) and defenseman **Derrick Pouliot** (3 a) each extended their point streaks to three games last night with an assist on **Fix-Wolansky's** goal. Earlier today, the parent New York Rangers (NHL) reassigned goaltender **Callum Tung** to the ECHL's Bloomington Bison from the Wolf Pack. Earlier this week, **Brisson** was named to the AHL All-Star Classic, replacing forward **Gabe Perreault**. It will be **Brisson's** first All-Star appearance.

#### Bruins Notebook:

The Bruins won their ninth straight game last night and improved to 10-1-0-0 in their last eleven games. The victory marked the fifth straight for the Bruins on home ice against the Wolf Pack. Goaltender **Michael DiPietro** made 28 saves to collect the victory, his 20<sup>th</sup> of the season. He now leads the AHL in wins this season. **Merkulov** scored twice in the victory last night and has scored four goals in five games against the Wolf Pack this season. He is the Bruins' all-time leader in points with 214 (86 g, 128 a) in 242 career games.
