Head-to-head:

This is the fourth and final meeting of the season between the Wolf Pack and the Monsters. The Wolf Pack hold a 2-1-0-0 edge in the series to this point, while the Monsters are 1-2-0-0. The road team is 3-0-0-0 thus far. The Wolf Pack claimed a 6-4 victory in Cleveland on Nov. 28, then completed the weekend sweep on Nov. 29 with a 3-2 comeback victory. The Monsters returned the favor with a 3-2 triumph at PeoplesBank Arena on Wednesday night. **Scott Morrow** put the Wolf Pack ahead 15:02 into the second period, beating **Ivan Fedotov** by the left pad off a faceoff win. **Brendan Gaunce** tied the game with a power play strike at 16:21, however, then **Luca Del Bel Belluz** put the Monsters ahead at 19:07 off a failed zone exit. **Morrow** tied the game with his second goal of the night 15:33 into the third period, banking a shot off **Fedotov** from the right-wing side. Moments later, however, a turnover proved costly as **Gaunce** gained possession behind the net and flung a centering pass to **Zach Aston-Reese**. **Aston-Reese** buried the eventual game-winning goal at 17:47.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack's loss dropped them to 5-3-0-0 in their last eight games. **Trey Fix-Wolansky** leads the Hartford attack in the season series, having scored three goals against his former team. **Morrow** and **Bryce McConnell-Barker** have each scored twice in the head-to-head series. **Morrow's** two-goal outing on Wednesday night gave the Wolf Pack their fourth multi-goal scorer in the last three games. The Wolf Pack are currently 22-28-4-2 on the season. They sit four points behind the Lehigh Valley Phantoms (54 pts) for the final playoff spot in the Atlantic Division. The Wolf Pack are six points behind the Bridgeport Islanders (56 pts) for the fifth spot in the Division. The Wolf Pack and Islanders will play three more times this season.

Monsters Notebook:

The Monsters snapped a two-game skid on the road on Wednesday night with their win at PeoplesBank Arena. The victory was also the first regulation win in franchise history against the Wolf Pack. **Del Bel Belluz** leads the way offensively in the season series for the Monsters with seven points (3 g, 4 a) in three games. The Monsters were one-for-four on the power play on Wednesday night. They are three-for-eleven in the season series. **Mikael Pyyhtiä** picked up an assist on Wednesday night, snapping a five-game point drought. The assist was his third against the Wolf Pack in as many games this season.
