Head-to-head:

This is the eighth of ten meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Bruins this season. It is the fourth of five meetings between the foes in Hartford. The Bruins have claimed five of the first seven meetings, going 5-2-0-0. The Wolf Pack have collected points in four of the first seven meetings, going 2-3-1-1. The Wolf Pack claimed the most recent meeting, 5-2, over the Bruins in Providence on Feb. 22. **Trey Fix-Wolansky** opened the scoring 4:03 into the game, putting the Pack ahead for good. **Dylan Roobroeck** and **Brandon Scanlin** also lit the lamp in the opening frame, giving Hartford a 3-0 edge. **Adam Sýkora** made it 4-0 at 1:37 of the middle frame, potting a rebound. **Patrick Brown** and **Victor Söderström** got the Bruins to within 4-2 by the 3:58 mark of the third period, but **Fix-Wolansky** put the game out of reach at 15:10 with a power play blast. **Fix-Wolansky** (2 g, 1 a) and **Roobroeck** (1 g, 2 a) each finished the game with three points. The Wolf Pack are 1-1-0-1 at home against the Bruins this season.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack dropped a 6-3 decision to the Lehigh Valley Phantoms on Sunday afternoon at the PPL Center, snapping their three-game winning streak. The Phantoms jumped out to a 2-0 lead 7:24 into the game, but two goals in 3:21 got the Wolf Pack even. **Anton Blidh** tipped home a **Brett Berard** shot at 10:25 to make it a 2-1 game, then **Juuso Pärssinen** potted a loose puck from the right-wing circle at 13:46 to make it 2-2. **Alex Bump** tipped home a **Christian Kyrou** shot 1:34 into the middle frame, giving the Phantoms the lead for good. **Cooper Marody** made it 4-2 at 16:55, then 6:33 into the third period **Lane Pederson** shoveled home a power play goal to make it 5-2. **Brennan Othmann** struck from the left-wing circle at 7:52 to make it 5-3, but **Anthony Richard's** second goal of the game at 11:40 put the Phantoms out of reach. The Wolf Pack split their weekend in Allentown thanks to a 5-4 shootout victory on Saturday night. On Monday, the club recalled F **Zakary Karpa** from loan to ECHL Bloomington. On Tuesday, the parent New York Rangers (NHL) assigned F **Brendan Brisson** and D **Scott Morrow** to the Wolf Pack.

Bruins Notebook:

The Bruins won their third straight game on Sunday afternoon, holding off the Bridgeport Islanders by a score of 3-2. **Riley Duran** opened the scoring 3:23 into the middle frame, but **Cam Berg** drew the Isles even at 12:44. **Matthew Poitras** restored the lead at 16:55, putting the Bruins ahead for good. **Matej Bumel** struck at 19:54, extending the lead to 3-1. The Islanders pushed in the third period, outshooting the Bruins 8-4, but they could only get it to 3-2. **Adam Beckman** potted his 22<sup>nd</sup> goal of the season 1:33 into the period, but **Michael DiPietro** slammed the door shut from there. The Bruins are tied with the Grand Rapids Griffins for the league-lead in wins with 41. They are 20-4-1-0 on the road this season.
