Head-to-head:

This is the ninth of 12 meetings between the Wolf Pack and the Islanders this season. It is the fifth of six meetings between the foes in Hartford. The Islanders have claimed five of the first eight meetings, going 5-3-0-0. The Wolf Pack are 3-5-0-0 in that span. The Islanders won the most recent meeting between the sides, 6-3 in Hartford on Jan. 30. **Julien Gauthier** and **Hunter Drew** had the Isles up 2-0 after one, scoring at 8:35 and 13:27 of the first period, respectively. **Drew** completed a natural hat-trick with goals at 5:26 and 6:05 of the second period, making it 4-0. **Matthew Maggio** then extended the lead to 5-0 at 16:48. Three goals in the third period drew the Wolf Pack to within 5-3. **Jaroslav Chmelář**, **Cooper Moore**, and **Daniel Walcott** lit the lamp for Hartford. **Liam Foudy** hit the empty net at 19:06, however, putting the game out of reach. The Wolf Pack are 1-3-0-0 at home against the Islanders this season. They have been shutout twice on home ice by the Islanders, 3-0 on Oct. 24 and 4-0 on Dec. 31.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack dropped their second straight game, 3-2 to the Providence Bruins on home ice on Wednesday night. **Trey Fix-Wolansky** put the Wolf Pack ahead 2:38 into the game, potting his team-leading 19th goal of the season. **Derrick Pouliot** then extended the lead to 2-0 at 6:36 of the second period, blasting a power play goal from the point. Two goals in 1:28 from the Bruins had the game 2-2 going into the third. **Frederic Brunet** made it 2-1 at 12:32, then **Riley Tuft** notched a power play goal at 14:00. **Matt Poitras** then put the Bruins ahead for good at 18:11 of the third period. His eleventh goal of the season was the second-latest game-winning goal allowed by Hartford this season. The Wolf Pack are just 8-14-3-1 at home this season. They are tied with the Rockford IceHogs for the fewest home wins in the AHL.

Islanders Notebook:

The Islanders were swept by the Bruins in a weekend back-to-back set in Rhode Island. Their last result was a 3-2 regulation defeat on Sunday afternoon. **Riley Duran** opened the scoring 3:23 into the middle frame, but **Cam Berg** responded at 12:44 to make it a 1-1 tilt. **Poitras** put the Bruins ahead for good at 16:55, making it 2-1. **Matej Blumel** then scored the game-winning goal at 19:54, his 13th of the season. **Adam Beckman** got the Islanders within one at 1:33 of the third period, but **Michael DiPietro** would slam the door shut from there as the Bruins hung on for two points. The Islanders are 10-12-2-3 on the road this season. They are just 3-4-1-2 in their last ten games overall.
