Head-to-head:

This is the tenth and final meeting between the Wolf Pack and Bruins this season. The Bruins have won seven of the first nine meetings, posting a record of 7-2-0-0. The Wolf Pack have points in four of the first nine meetings, going 2-5-1-1. The Bruins claimed the most recent meeting, 7-0 in Providence on Mar. 14. **Ty Gallagher** recorded his first career hat trick in the win, while **Victor Söderström** struck twice. Six of the seven Bruin goals came off the stick of defensemen, as **Michael Callahan** also lit the lamp. **Lukas Reichel** had three assists for the Bruins, while **Michael DiPietro** made 13 saves to collect the shutout. The Bruins also claimed the last meeting in Hartford, 3-2 on Mar. 4. The Wolf Pack's last victory against the Bruins came on Feb. 22 in Providence by a final score of 5-2. The Wolf Pack's lone home win against the Bruins was on Jan. 10 by a score of 5-1.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack dropped their sixth straight game (0-4-1-1) last Saturday night by a final score of 8-1 to the Hershey Bears. **Andrew Cristall** scored at 1:16 and 14:23 of the first period, giving the Bears a 2-0 edge through 20 minutes. **Byce McConnell-Barker** got the Wolf Pack on the board ten seconds into the middle frame, but 2-1 was as close as the club would draw it. Four goals in 7:59 allowed the Bears to take control. **Ilya Protas** made it 3-1 at 3:37, then **Kyler Kupka**, **Bogdan Trineyev**, and **Dalton Smith** all lit the lamp to expand the lead to 6-1. **Trineyev** potted his second goal of the night 8:20 into the third period, then **Cristall** completed the hat trick at 16:25. The loss was the Pack's fifth straight on home ice (0-3-1-1). The Wolf Pack are 1-2-0-1 at home against the Bruins this season. On Tuesday, the Wolf Pack recalled F **Kyle Jackson** from loan to the ECHL's Bloomington Bison.

Bruins Notebook:

The Bruins fell 2-1 in overtime to the Rochester Americans at Blue Cross Arena on Apr. 4. **Anton Wahlberg** opened the scoring 3:31 into the game for the Amerks, but **Söderström** tied the affair at 12:02 on the power play. Neither side was able to breakthrough in the final 40 minutes of regulation time. The Amerks held a slight 13-12 edge in shots in the second and third periods. In overtime, the Amerks fired all four shots on net. They broke through on the fourth shot, as **Matteo Costantini** recorded his fifth goal of the season at 4:17. The loss dropped the Bruins to 3-2-0-0 in their last five games. The Bruins are 3-1-0-0 at PeoplesBank Arena this season. On Wednesday, the parent Boston Bruins (NHL) signed F **James Hagens** to a three-year, entry-level contract, ending his stint in Providence. Selected seventh overall last June, **Hagens** had four points (1 g, 3 a) in six AHL games.
