Head-to-head:

This is the second and final meeting of the season between the Wolf Pack and the Rocket. The Rocket claimed a 4-2 victory in the first meeting last Friday night at Place Bell. **Brendan Brisson** and **Scott Morrow** scored power play goals for the Wolf Pack, giving them a 2-1 lead through two periods of play. **Joshua Roy** tied the game just 47 seconds into the third period, however, as the home side struck three times in the final stanza to collect the two points. **Alex Belzile** potted the game-winning goal 14:04 into the period, beating **Dylan Garand** on a second chance opportunity from the slot during a four-minute power play. **Tobie Bisson** then hit the empty net at 19:33 to cement the victory. The Rocket took three of four meetings a season ago and are 4-1-0-0 in their last five against the Wolf Pack. Hartford's last victory against the Rocket came on Dec. 14, 2024, in Hartford by a final score of 4-2. **Belzile** scored the game-winning goal for the Wolf Pack that night, while **Garand** made 34 saves to collect the victory and third star honors.

Wolf Pack Notebook:

The Wolf Pack dropped their sixth game in a row last night (0-2-4-0), 4-3 to the Rochester Americans in overtime. **Blake Hillman** opened the scoring 1:57 into the hockey game with a shot from the point through traffic, then **Anton Blidh** made it 2-0 at 7:18 when he finished off a two-on-one with **Brennan Othmann**. **Oliver Nadeau** got the Americans on the board at 9:48, but **Jaroslav Chmelař** restored the two-goal lead at 16:21. **Trevor Kuntar** led the charge for the Amerks from there. **Kuntar** made it 3-2 at 11:43 of the second period, striking from the left-wing circle. Then, at 17:05 of the third period, he tipped a **Jack Rathbone** shot home on the power play to force overtime. In overtime, **Riley Fiddler-Schultz** completed the comeback at 1:05. The loss was Hartford's third in a row at home. Despite that, they have points in four straight (1-0-3-0) at PeoplesBank Arena.

Rocket Notebook:

The Rocket dropped a 3-1 decision to the Springfield Thunderbirds on Wednesday morning in the club's 'School Day Game'. **Nikita Alexandrov** gave the Thunderbirds a lead they never lost 14:20 into the game, lightning the lamp for the second time this season. **Hugh McGing** extended the lead at 10:48 of the third period, his second of the season as well. **McGing's** strike would stand as the eventual game-winning goal. **Luke Tuch** got the Rocket on the board at 11:56 of the third, but **Matt Luff** hit the empty net at 19:08 to secure the victory for the Thunderbirds. **Vadim Zherenko** made 24 saves to collect the victory for Springfield. **Jared Davidson**, who scored last Friday against the Wolf Pack, leads the Rocket in goals with nine on the season. **Laurent Dauphin** paces the club in points with 14 (8 g, 6 a) in 13 games.
